Cumbrian Challenge Trophy for highest placed horse/rider combination competing in BE80(T), BE90, BE100 (and Novice classes), accumulating points at all the events located in Cumbria including Eden Valley (April), Cumwhinton (June), Hutton International Horse Trials (1) (June); and Hutton in the Forest (2) (September). The trophy in 2012 will be an accumulation of points from all four events and the winner will be presented at Hutton in the Forest (2).

Course description

Eden Valley Horse Trials is sited on sandy soil and old turf and the course will be a straightforward and flowing early season event and will include a water fence and a few combination fences. A new track through the woodland area above the water fence will be included for the BE90 & BE100 classes. Ideal for a first time early season event. Additional ground has been secured for 2 dressage arenas and this will give more space for the dressage warm up area and the spring which caused some problems last

year has been drained away. The show jumping will be within an all weather 80m x 40m arena.
